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Scope and Motivation

IEEE CCECE 2027 solicits proposals for half-day or full-day workshops, to be held in conjunction with the main conference on May 24–27, 2027.

The aim of the workshops is to emphasize emerging, specialized, or interdisciplinary topics not specifically covered in the main conference tracks. Workshops should highlight the latest trends in electrical and computer engineering, offering a forum for active discussion. Workshops may include a mix of regular papers, invited talks, keynotes, and panel discussions.

Workshop Proposal Format

The proposal should concisely and clearly describe the content and objectives of the workshop. Proposals must not exceed **5 pages** and must include the following information:

1. **Title of the workshop.**
2. **Description of the technical issues covered**, emphasizing the timeliness and relevance of the proposed workshop to the ECE community.

3. **Topics not covered or specifically addressed by the main conference tracks** (1 page maximum).
4. **Workshop Organizers** (names, affiliations, and contact information).
5. **A short biography of the organizers** (up to 200 words per organizer), highlighting any previous conferences or workshops chaired, especially within IEEE.
6. **Names of potential participants**, such as technical program committee (TPC) members and invited speakers (indicating if speakers have already accepted to participate is a strong plus).
7. **Planned format of the workshop**, including the duration (Half-day or Full-day), a tentative schedule, and any preferred dates.
8. **Plan for the review of refereed papers**, confirming adherence to standard IEEE academic best practices and peer-review policies.
9. **Draft Call for Papers (CFP)** (1 page maximum).
10. **A description of the publicity and promotion plan** to attract high-quality submissions and attendees.
11. **History of the workshop** (if applicable), including a description of past versions, the number of submitted and accepted papers, and the number of attendees.

Workshop Proposal Submission

Proposals should be submitted as a single PDF file, not exceeding 5 pages, for review through Sparcly.
